

### **OLYMPIA UNION GOSPEL MISSION VISION CLINIC**

Volunteer Optometrists perform vision examinations and prescribe eyeglasses. The Mission utilizes donated eyeglass frames and new lenses to restore vision to those who cannot afford to pay for eye care. Currently, the clinic operates each Monday evening and alternate Tuesday evenings (5 to 6 patients seen per clinic) and it takes about 2 weeks for a patient to receive their eyeglasses after the examination.

Household income at or below 200% FPL with no vision benefits are eligible.

### **OLYMPIA UNION GOSPEL MISSION DENTAL CLINIC**

The OUGM dental clinic is primarily for dental emergencies involving pain and infection. Volunteer dentists and dental professionals donate their time to staff the clinic, generally 3 days a week. The clinic is open 5 days a week for patient screening and scheduling.

#### **Eligibility**

Household income at or below 150 % FPL with no dental benefits are eligible.

### **OLYMPIA UNION GOSPEL MISSION CHRONIC DISEASE PRIMARY CARE MEDICAL CLINIC**

Volunteer medical providers and allied medical professionals provide primary care services to qualified patients with: diabetes, hypertension, heart disease, COPD and asthma. The goal of the clinic is to be an interim medical home, providing 6-9 months of support for a patient to better control their chronic illness.

Household income at or below 200% FPL with no medical benefits.

### **SEA MAR COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER**

Sea Mar Community Health Centers is a community-based organization committed to providing quality, comprehensive health and human services to diverse communities, specializing in service to Latinos. Sea Mar is a family practice clinic and does not provide specialty care or chronic pain management.

#### **Eligibility**

Sea Mar has no eligibility requirements and will take patients on sliding scale.

## **THURSTON COUNTY PROJECT ACCESS (TCPA)**

TCPA is a physician-led initiative which provides short-term access to donated medical services for clients who have a medical need and are uninsured.

### **Eligibility**

A client must be 18 or older, uninsured, at or below 200% FPL, be a Thurston County resident, and have a medical referral to be enrolled in TCPA.

## **MENTAL HEALTH ACCESS PROGRAM (MHAP)**

MHAP is a community-based mental health clinic developed to improve access to basic mental health services in Thurston County. Volunteer therapists provide free counseling to Thurston County residents over 18, who are uninsured or under-insured and troubled by anxiety and depression. CHOICE provides case management during the once-a-week clinic. Clients are accepted to the program after being screened by a referring medical professional.

### **Eligibility**

A client must be a Thurston County resident over the age of 18 who is uninsured or underinsured (insurance doesn't cover behavioral health).

## **EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT CONSISTENT CARE PROGRAM (EDCCP)**

Participating emergency departments identify and refer "frequent flyers" to the ED, often suffering from narcotic pain addiction and mental illness, co-occurring with chronic illness, to participate in EDCCP. Patient care is coordinated among hospitals, primary care, and CHOICE (case management) to reduce inappropriate use of the ED, increase capacity and integration of safety net services, and improve enrolled clients' health status.

### **Eligibility**

Referrals for this program may come from participating hospitals, PCP's, and payers only. Income and residency criteria are not considered.
